

Privacy Notice

This notice describes how the website is managed with reference to processing of the personal data of users visiting the site. It contains general information regarding the protection of personal data, in accordance with [Article 13 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003](#) - Personal data protection code, for persons interacting with VEM's web services accessible on the Internet from the following websites: www.vem.it The notice applies to VEM's site only, and does not cover any other websites accessed by users by means of the links.

The "holder" of the processing

The details concerning persons identified or identifiable after consulting this site may be processed. These details will be processed by the company's Internet and Marketing Department, and may be passed on to companies belonging to the Iris group. The "holder" of the processing is VEM SPA, con sede in Italia in via Lago di Annone, 36015 Schio (VI)

Place of processing of the data

The processing associated with the web services of this site is carried out at the premises of VEM SPA and is taken care of solely by the technical personnel of the department entrusted with processing or, at the time of occasional maintenance activities, by the relevant personnel. No data originating from the web service is notified or circulated to third parties outside the Iris group. The personal details supplied by users requesting information material are used only for the purpose of providing the service being requested, and are passed on to third parties only when necessary in order to provide the service.

Type of data processed

- **Navigation data**

As part of their normal functioning, the information systems and software procedures used to run this website acquire some personal details, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet protocols. The information is not collected for the purpose of being associated with specific identified parties, however due to its very nature it would be possible to identify users by processing the information and associating it with information held by third parties. This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers of users visiting the site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the resources requested, the time and date of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server and other parameters referred to the user's operating system and IT environment. These data are used solely for the purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical data concerning use of the site and of monitoring its proper functioning. The data could be used in order to investigate liability in relation to possible IT offences to the detriment of the site.

- **Data provided voluntarily by the user**

When optional electronic mail is sent explicitly and voluntarily to the addresses indicated on this site, the personal data supplied are acquired. These include the e-mail address needed in order to answer queries and any other data included in the message. Specific summary data will entered or displayed on the pages of the site provided for special on-demand services.

- **Cookies**

Our site may send you some small data files called cookies, used to analyse the traffic at the site anonymously and to offer you customised contents. If you do not wish to receive them, you can either de-activate them directly on your browser or refuse them from time to time if you have opted for your browser to inform you whenever the presence of a cookie is detected.

Optional nature of the provision of data

Apart from what we have stated about navigation data, the user may decide whether or not to provide the personal data requested from time to time by VEM SPA. Failure to do so may make it impossible to provide the services requested.

Processing mode

The personal data are processed using automated tools for the time strictly necessary in order to achieve the aims for which they were acquired. Specific safety measures are observed in order to prevent the loss, unlawful or incorrect use of the data and unauthorised access thereto.

Rights of the parties concerned

We would like to inform you that all the e-mail addresses appearing on our database are taken from public directories, published on the web or with the authorisation of the owners. The said data will be treated in accordance with and in full respect of the Decree Law No.196/2003 (D.Lgs.196/2003), that grants the interested party the right to obtain confirmation of whether the data exist, to

request their modification or elimination and to contest their processing. In accordance with Art. 7, par. 4, lett. b) of the mentioned Decree Law No. 196/2003, the interested party shall have the right to object wholly or partially to the processing of his/her personal data for the forwarding of this newsletter, by sending an e-mail to the present address: vem@vem.it
